



# SKILLS FOR LIFE

Skills for Life support the individual English and Mathematic needs of learners on vocational programmes. Classes are tailored to meet individual needs, abilities and interests, with learners taught in small groups. We also aim to develop learning skills by encouraging self-reliance, initiative, personal responsibility, and consideration for others.

Skills for Life offers a range of programmes in Functional English and Functional Mathematics, to suit the individual needs and differing levels of ability of learners. We offer courses aimed at Entry Level, Levels 1 and 2. The variety of programmes allows for progression through the levels towards examinations at Levels 1 and 2.

## Foundation Learning

### Entry Level English

#### Entry 1 – 3

This qualification is divided into three sub levels Entry 1, Entry 2 and Entry 3 for Reading, Writing and Communication. These qualifications are assessed by assignments, which are taken when the individual learner is ready. Learners have the opportunity to take another assessment should they be unsuccessful at their first attempt.

### Entry Level Mathematics

#### Entry 1 - 3

This qualification is assessed by assignment. This enables the individual needs of learners to be met and allows for progression through the levels towards the Mathematics examination at Levels 1 and 2.

### English Functional Skill

#### Levels 1 & 2

This qualification is assessed by a paper based test, which is nationally set.

### Mathematics Functional Skill

#### Levels 1 & 2
