Foundation Learning

Child Development Entry Level

This course is to give learners the opportunity to study both the practical and theoretical aspects of Child Development. It covers parenthood and pregnancy, physical development and nutrition and health among other things.

Foundation & beyond...

National First Award/National Award/National Certificate in Health & Social Care Level 1

The OCR Level 1 Nationals in Health & Social Care provide learners with an introduction to the knowledge, understanding and skills required to prepare for work in the health and social care sector. They also help learners to develop their personal skills in areas such as team working, career planning, communication and problem solving.

BTEC First Certificate/Diploma in Children's Care, Learning & Development Level 2

These qualifications cover understanding Children's Development, Keeping Children Safe, Communication with Children and Adults. Preparing and Maintenance Environments for Child Care, Professional Development and Roles and Responsibilities in Child Care.

Nationals Certificate & Diploma in Health, Social Care and Early Years Level 3

This Health, Social Care and Early Years qualification allows learners to cover a range of information including, Working to quality practice in care settings, Working with service users in care setting, Behavioural awareness in Care, Applied practical care and the choice of a wide range of option units that can be specifically related to health, social care or early years and education specialist pathways.

Additional Qualifications
