We have been to the forest school and made fires, climbed trees and toasted marshmallows, it was great fun!

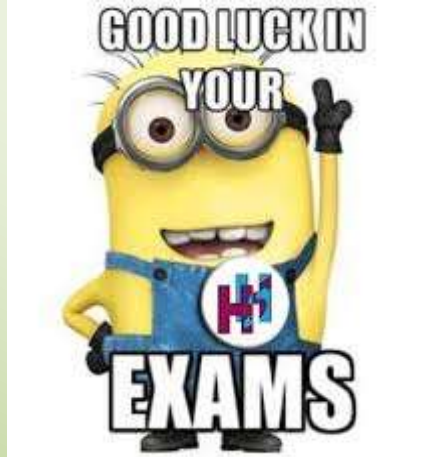


We even did a bit of karaoke and dancing, 'Britain's Got Talent' has got nothing on us!
