After a long time apart we are at last back in school



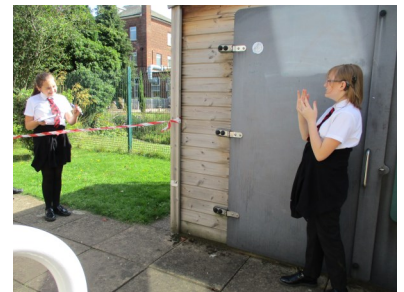

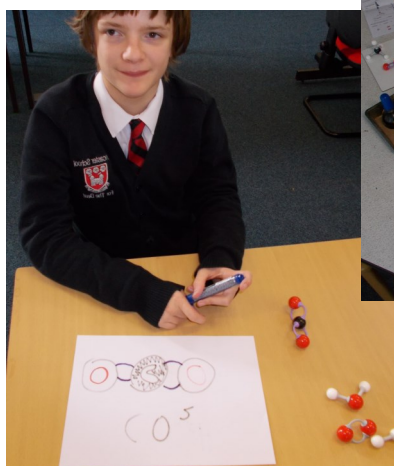
...creating an exciting Literacy Shed, reading together for fun and listening to a class reading of the moving "Why the Whales" came story.

... testing the products made by chemical reactions.

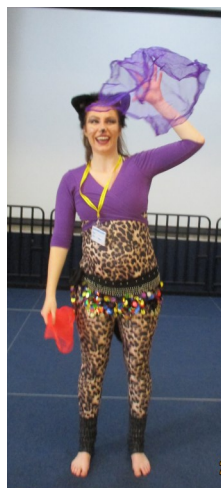


...testing the parts of the Water Cycle in primary Geography

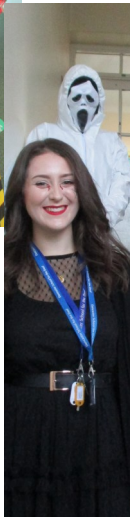
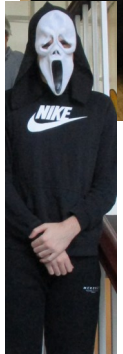
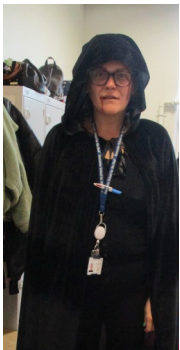
