We have spent time at the park!



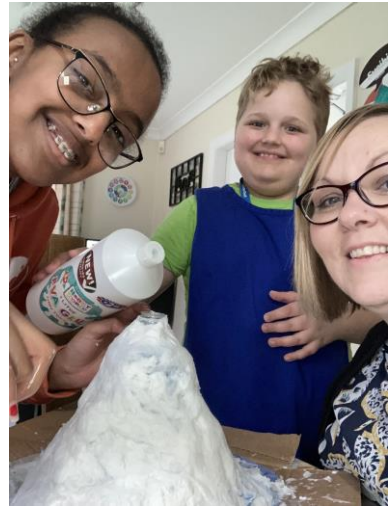
We have had 'play dates' with school friends who live locally, going to places such as Astrobound and the trampoline park.

We went to the arcades.



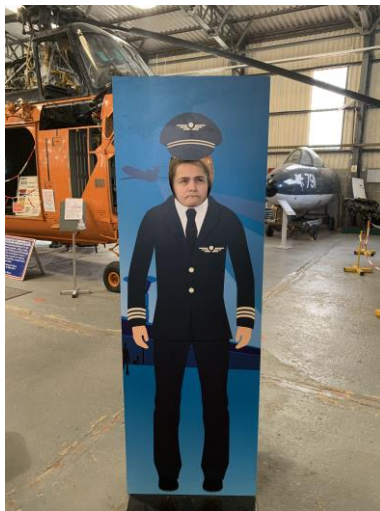
We went ice skating, it was amazing.
